



# Step-by-Step with Modern Masters

RECIPE N° 4 | Circular Logic

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Stenciling with both Matte Metallics and the Metallic Paint Collection will add an elevated look and style to your surface. There are many colors to choose from both product lines and you can customize this finish to taste with both pattern and tones.

## PRODUCTS NEEDED

## TOOLS NEEDED

- 3 Stencil Brushes – one for each color
- Small Artist Brush
- Painters Tape or Stencil Spray Adhesive
- Paper Towels



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STEP 1: Base area with two coats English Brown Metallic Paint. Let dry 1 hour between coats.

STEP 2: Apply stencil to the surface using painters tape or stencil spray adhesive to hold in place. Dip your stencil brush into the Platinum/Silver Matte Metallic and swirl the brush onto a clean dry rag to remove excess paint. Pounce your stencil brush over the entire circle. Repeat this process on several of the circles creating a pattern of Platinum/Silver Matte Metallic circles that is pleasing to you. You can repeat when it quickly dries for more opacity. Repeat the process with the Champagne Matte Metallic and Brass Matte Metallic.

STEP 3: Remove the stencil and let dry 1 hour. Clean up any seepage with the English Brown Metallic Paint and a small artist brush. You will see the beautiful variations between the sheen of the Matte Metallics and the Metallic Paint.
